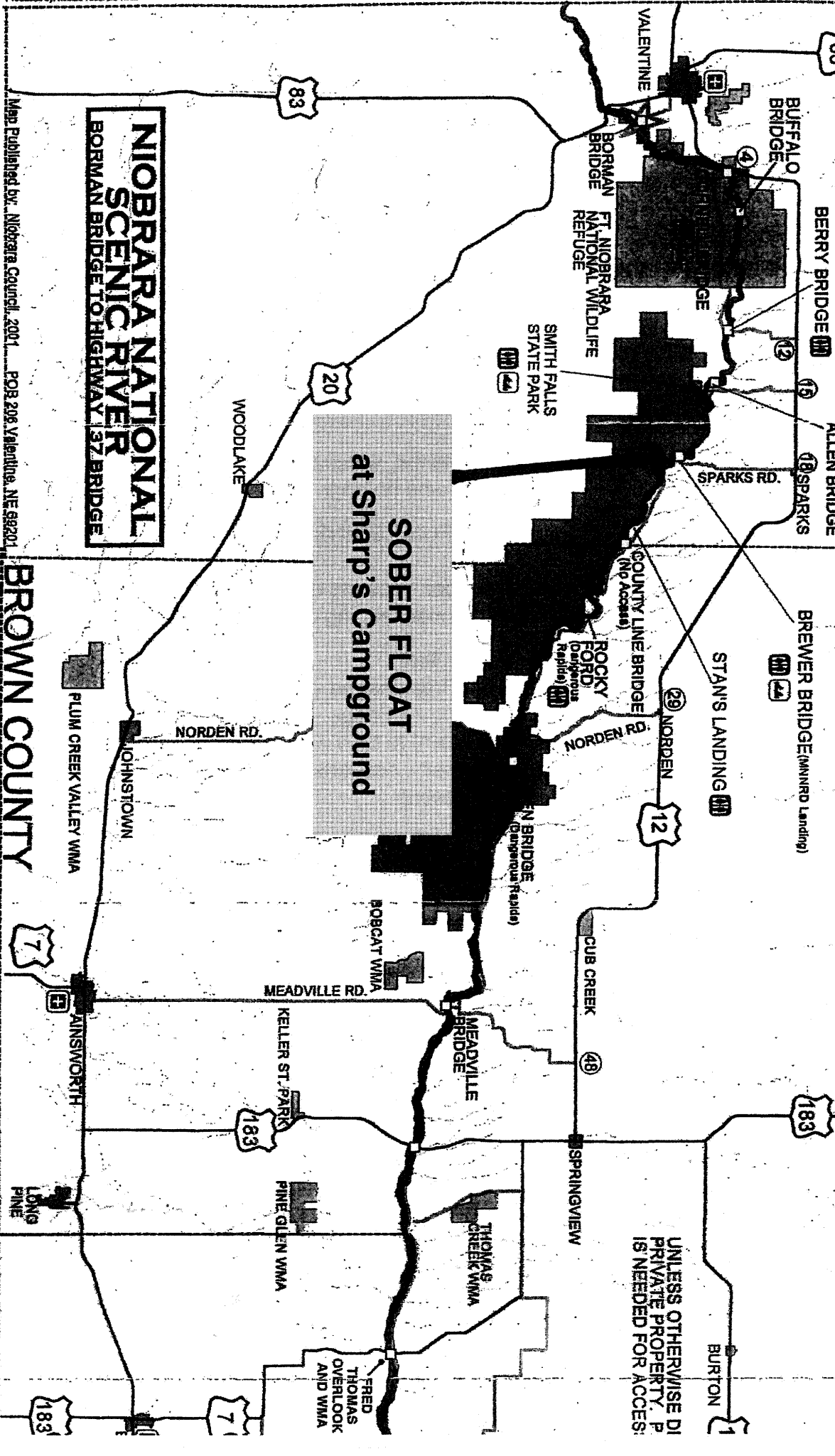

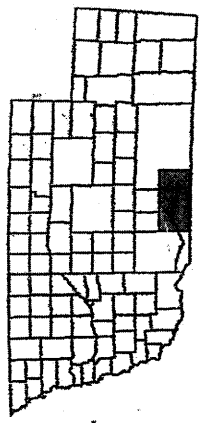


**NIORARA NATIONAL SCENIC RIVER**
